
Fulfilling Germany's EV target requires 6,700 new registrations each day

The chart shows additions to the German all-electric vehicle fleet measured in terms of average new registrations per day. Historical data are displayed for January 2021 to March 2025; the line and the bars from January 2025 show the required rate of new EV registrations.



Battery-electric cars: Historical data for daily new EV registrations

Agora Verkehrswende (4/2025) | The target rate for daily new registrations is derived from the German government's goal to have 15 million all-electric cars on the road by the end of 2030. At least **6,700 all-electric cars** must be registered each day starting in 2024 to reach the target of **15 million all-electric cars** on the road by the end of 2030.
